

The Theatre Organ Society of the Delaware Valley presents the Halloween silent movie, **Nosferatu**, This 1922 German Expressionist horror film is a loose adaptation of Bram Stoker's Dracula. Unable to obtain the rights to the novel, the German film makers changed names and other details. However, for Dracula fans...the story is quite familiar. Wayne Zimmerman will provide accompaniment on the TOSDV Wurlitzer Opus 585, 3-manual, 24 rank theatre pipe organ.

Nosferatu will be shown Sunday, October 28, 2012, 3 PM, at the Colonial Theatre, 227 Bridge St., Phoenixville, PA. Tickets, \$10 for adults and \$5 for children 12 and under, will be available at the door. Note that the Colonial assesses a \$1.50 fee on all tickets.

The next TOSDV organ program at the Colonial will be December 9, 2012 at 3PM, with a program which will include music for the end of Fall and beginning of Winter, the celebrations of Christmas, Hanukkah and the New Year, a silent comedy "short" and more. 
