

He was a kind and generous man who served in many churches and was known for giving away expensive instruments to churches that couldn't afford them. He is credited with keeping the York Organ Club together for many years.

I am very pleased to announce that we have scheduled a third public concert next year. I have an agreement with Mark Herman and SCPAC to do a public concert on June 2nd 2013. Mark is an internationally recognized organist and has performed for several ATOS conventions and has toured overseas in Australia and New Zealand. In July this year he received the "Organist of the Year" award from ATOS. He is the youngest organist to ever receive this prestigious award, presented annually to one organist in recognition of outstanding achievement in the field of performance on the theatre pipe organ. 


