Please use the correct memory level when setting your pistons. You can also use the club memory level #3 if you don't want to set your own pistons. If we have a large number of people signing up, we may schedule some additional open console days.



One of the dates in February or March (yet to be determined) will be reserved for a silent film which will be accompanied by Don Kinnier. The theatre is also interested in doing a Christmas program for 2016 which will use the organ. The new Strand-Capitol management is very supportive of the organ and SVTOS and we need to work as a partner with them to promote the organ as best we can.

I have also been in contact with the Allen Theater in Annville, PA and they are also interested in having more silent films at the Allen. We will be working with them in the near future to schedule more silent films. The Allen Theatre is now open again after installing a new digital projector, sound system, and making some needed renovations.

We also have new dates for our bi-monthly Masonic Village programs and we still need organists for April 12th, June 14th, and August 9th. Please call Ken Kline to sign up for these dates.

Coming up on March 14th will be the Father-and-Son team of Jack and Dan Umholtz at the Capitol Theatre for our first showcase of 2016. More info in our next newsletter.
