

DON KINNIER Accompanies the Silent Film Presentation "THE CRUISE OF THE JASPER B"

Capitol Theatre, York PA Monday, November 9th, 7:00 PM



"The Cruise of the Jasper B" is a 1926 American silent action/adventure comedy film produced by <u>Cecil B. DeMille</u> and directed by <u>James W. Horne</u>. The film is loosely based on the 1916 novel of the same name by American poet <u>Don Marquis</u>, although the film adaptation and novel share little in common.

The film stars actor <u>Rod La Rocque</u> as 'Jerry Cleggert', a good-natured descendant of an 18th-century pirate. Cleggert is informed that in order to inherit a large inheritance, he must marry on his twenty-fifth birthday - otherwise he would relinquish all claims to his impending fortune.

Jerry soon meets his ideal would-be bride Agatha Fairhaven (<u>Mildred Harris</u>) and the two immediately fall in love. Complications arise when the dastardly Reginald Maltravers (<u>Snitz Edwards</u>) attempts to cheat Agatha out of her inheritance.

The courting couple suffer a series of mishaps on the way to altar; they are waylaid en route by a trio of bandits, escape from a runaway taxi cab, and outrun a mob of state authorities. The weary couple finally manage to wed just before the deadline on board the *Jasper B* and Cleggert inherits his family fortune.

CONTR'S The new Artisan relay and combination action have now been installed on the Capitol Wurlitzer. Glenn Hough put it to the test on Monday October 12th for our first showcase meeting. After setting his pistons and playing a few numbers, Glenn remarked how fast the new relay responded. While the organ doesn't sound any different, this change is a major improvement for the organist. The key and piston actions are much faster and there are many more memory levels to store combinations in the organ (from 8 to 100). Glenn did a terrific job as usual entertaining us with a variety of popular tunes and theatre organ favorites. We all enjoyed his program. We were pleased to have as our special guest, Mr. Todd Fogdall, the new President and CEO of the Strand-Capitol Performing Arts Center. He was very impressed with the program and the organ and wants to use the organ as much as possible. We look forward to working with him on future programs and appreciate his support of the organ and SVTOS.

Our November 9th program is at the Capitol Theatre and will feature the silent film entitled "Cruise of the Jasper B" starring Rod La Rocque, Mildred Harris, Snitz Edwards, and Jack Ackroyd. It is a 1926 American silent action/adventure comedy film produced by Cecil B. DeMille and directed by James W. Horne.
