The Wednesday evening, October 21st virtual Zoom hosted chapter meeting was very useful for me to get a feeling of how to plan the current membership year (September to June plus a picnic). As a result of the discussion, here's the plan to support a "socially distanced" profile

1. Hold monthly virtual Chapter meetings in November and December 2020
2. Support Capitol Theatre with organ prelude music before their movies. Thus far that includes three weekend showings of *White Christmas*. Continue this as required based upon theatre plans.
3. Schedule Open Console events for January and February of 2021.
4. Plan Chapter meetings for March to June 2021 to include either Zoom or SVTOS Facebook events. Zoom events will potentially include organ related presentations and portions of one or two privately recorded theatre organ concerts.
5. Potentially an ATOS Convention in July. This is on for now, but there is serious concern about what level of attendance might be possible.
6. Late July or early August will be a Picnic of some type.

Beyond summer of 2021 (for planning purposes) series of programs will be planned including one Fall of 2021 and one Spring of 2022 public concert at the Capitol Theatre along with returning to monthly Monday night Chapter meetings at 7 PM. During the Spring of 2022, one month we will plan on an event at Opus 501.

Other ideas discussed including having Chapter playing members develop short programs that can be video recorded to create a "Members Showcase" on the SVTOS Facebook page. Taping will be done on either member's instruments or at the Capitol. The goal is to complete the effort before the holiday season.

During the meeting an offer of a DVD created from either of our three Facebook Live events was made for those that cannot access the events on-line. The events were Seamus Gethicker Virtual Picnic, Mark Herman at Walker 3/51 and Mark Herman at Opus 501. Please e-mail pres@svtos.org with your requests.

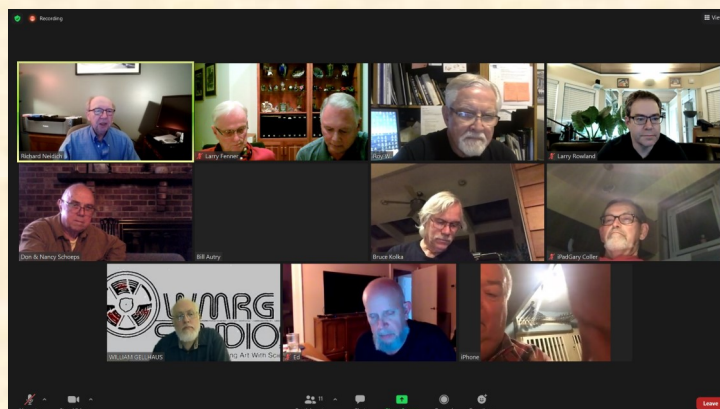
