

# MONDAY, OCTOBER 9TH AT 7:00 PM CAPITOL THEATRE, YORK, PA



This first-of-its-kind organ designed to play for an outdoor audience has been amazing music-lovers since December 31, 1914, when from his presidential desk Woodrow Wilson touched the telegraph key that set off fireworks and lit the Pavilion's 1,644 incandescent bulbs to launch the Panama-California International Exposition.

Entering the 21st Century with 4,518 pipes in 73 ranks, the Spreckels Organ is the largest outdoor organ in the Western Hemisphere and continues to offer free programs of the full range of musical masterworks thanks to a cooperative partnership between the City of San Diego and the Spreckels Organ Society.

The Austin pipe organ, and the Pavilion designed by Harrison Albright to house it, were a gift from brothers John and Adolph Spreckels to the people of the world, offering free music in the days before commercial ratio, television, or movies with sound.

Join the past Civic Organist Dr. Carol Williams for live performances on this great organ, an exclusive tour inside this mammoth instrument, interviews with the previous Civic Organists and much more. Discover the history of this unique American treasure.

And on Saturday October 21st at 4pm Don will be accompany "The Great K & A Train Robbery" starring Tom Mix, Dorothy Dwan, and Tony the horse. It is an action-packed Western with a healthy dose of comedy and romance. This performance is being sponsored by The Reed Organ Society. I strongly urge all of our members to come out and support both these programs. These silent films are open to the public and there will be an admission charge. More silent films are being planned for early 2018 but are not yet confirmed.

A big **Thank You!** to all of our volunteers for providing their time and talents by playing the organ before the Capitol movies. We are in need of a few more dedicated organists to help by providing some walk-in music. We have been stretched very thin lately and can use some more organists. If you would like to volunteer, please contact Ken Kline or me and we can work with you to get some practice time on the organ.

SVTOS is a local chapter of The American Theatre Organ Society (ATOS) and we encourage all of our members to also join the national organization. There are many benefits including a bimonthly magazine, youth programs, technical articles, annual convention, reduced dues for SVTOS, and many more.
