

CAPITOL THEATRE FREE HALLOWEEN FILM FESTIVAL

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 27TH 10:00 AM UNTIL 9:00 PM







A young author is hired by the owner of a wax museum to write tales about his most popular figures, Haroun al Raschid, Ivan the Terrible and Jack the Ripper. Entranced by his new boss's pretty daughter, the author sets to work writing about the wax figures. With each new story, the author and the boss's daughter find themselves pulled inside the progressively nightmarish worlds that he has invented.

SVTOS is a 501(c)(3) corporation dedicated to the preservation and presentation of Theatre Pipe Organs. Proudly supporting the Mighty WurliTzer Theatre Pipe Organ at the Capitol Theatre in York, PA.

Our first program for the new 2018-2019 season was held on Sunday September 16th at the Howard/Fenner residence in Lebanon, PA, and featured guest organist Justin Nimmo playing the 3/16 Wurlitzer Opus 501. Justin did an outstanding job playing many theatre organ favorites, including medleys of music by Harry Warren, Duke Ellington, and Henry Mancini. Justin's arrangements and registrations made full use of the dynamic range of the organ. All of our members enjoyed his program and we certainly welcome him back in the future.

There will not be a regular SVTOS meeting in October, but the Capitol Theatre will have their Grand Reopening on the last weekend of October. On Saturday October 27th at 5:00 PM Don Kinnier will accompany the silent film "Waxworks" as part of the Capitol's all-day FREE Halloween Film Festival. "Waxworks" is a 1924 German fantasy/horror silent film directed by Paul Leni. While primarily known as a horror film, it is an anthology film that goes through various genres through its various episodes, including a fantasy film adventure, a historical film, and a horror film. Five other Halloween-themed films will also be shown all day from 10:00 AM to 9:00 PM and all are FREE to the public. Check out the list of films on the Appell Center website here. The Appell Center is also planning to have a preview "DRY RUN" at the Capitol Theatre on Monday October 22nd for SVTOS members and Appell Center employees and volunteers. More details will be provided as soon as they are available.

Our regular monthly meetings will resume at the Capitol Theatre on Monday November 12th at 7:00 PM with talented young organist Brett Miller who will accompany the silent film "The Cameraman" starring Buster Keaton. Brett is an excellent young organist and was a finalist in this year's Young Organist Competition at the ATOS Convention in Pasadena, CA. This will be Brett's first time playing for SVTOS.
