### **Tell everyone about this safety idea:**

Next time you come home for the night and start to put your keys away, think of this: You probably have a security alarm system that requires no installation. Check it out:

Put your car keys beside your bed at night. If you hear a noise outside your home or someone trying to break into your house, just press the panic button for your car. The alarm will be set off and the horn will continue to sound until either you turn it off or the car battery dies. Any burglar/attacker will not want to hear this, especially since your neighbors are likely to be looking out their windows if this goes on for long. (This will probably work everywhere inside your house, and whether your car is in the garage or in the driveway.)

Don't forget you have this panic button going to and from your car in a parking lot. Most of us forget about it until it goes off by accident!


