

The December 11th “Holiday Silent Film Fest” at the Capitol Theatre featured three short silent films: “The Adventure of the Wrong Santa Claus,” “Big Business,” and “Electric House.” The successful program was again accompanied by Don Kinnier who did a fantastic job as usual. This was the third silent film program at the Capitol in 2016 and we hope these programs will continue in 2017.

Our annual Christmas program was held at Masonic Village on December 13th in their Health Care Center auditorium. Performing their favorite Christmas selections this year were Gary Coller, Larry Fenner, Barry Howard, Don Kinnier, Ken Kline, Connor Ream, Don and Nancy Schoeps, and Judy Townsend accompanied by “Bella the Wonder Dog.” As always the “Jingle Bell” finale was a big hit with everyone and featured all of our SVTOS performers playing the piano, organ, real sleigh bells and sound effects.

We are starting the new year with two open console days at the Capitol on Monday January 16th and Monday February 20th. This is an opportunity for any SVTOS member to schedule some practice time on the 3/20 Wurlitzer. Don Schoeps will schedule and host the open consoles. The memory levels are posted on the SVTOS website and on the inside of the solo chamber door.

Our March 13th meeting will feature a video tour of the Spreckels Austin organ in Balboa Park in San Diego, CA, which is the world’s largest outdoor organ, and will be followed by an open console.

Our next showcase is on Monday April 10th and will feature SVTOS member, Frank Vanaman. This will be Frank’s second time playing for SVTOS and we are glad to welcome him back and to have him as a member.

In addition to our May 8th annual business meeting we are adding a video tour of Organ Supply Industries, Inc., located in Erie, PA. OSI is the largest supplier of pipe organ parts in the US. After the video we will have an open console along with several selections from our youngest member Cody McSherry. Cody played for us last May and we are excited to hear him again this May. He is a uniquely talented young musician who plays several musical instruments.

Our final showcase for this season is on June 12th and will feature guest organist Gary Phillips from Attleboro, MA. This will be Gary’s first time playing for SVTOS.

SVTOS members continue to play the organ before the Saturday night and first Friday films at the Capitol Theatre and also at Masonic village every other month. Thank you to all of our volunteers.
