Skip Stine is a graduate of the United States Navy School of Music.

In the 1960's, he played trumpet with numerous bands throughout the United States, Canada and Europe, including Cy Zentner, Buddy Morrow, and the Sammy Spear Orchestra for the Jackie Gleason Show, as well as playing for performers such as Frank Sinatra, Tony Bennett, Peggy Lee, Johnny Mathis, and many other musical stars of that time.

In the late 1960's, Skip joined the Harry James Orchestra traveling throughout the U.S. and Europe, performing in concert and club dates and appearing on many television and recording dates.

During that time, Skip married Cathy Chemi - the "girl singer" with the Harry James Orchestra. The couple continues to work throughout the U.S. in concert, recalling their memories and music of the Harry James Orchestra.

Skip has been performing with Ken Double since 2007. The musical duo have two recordings to their credit: *TRIBUTE*, recorded on the 3/66 Kimball at Dickinson H.S. in Wilmington, DE; and *LIVE IN INDY!* recorded on the 3/18 Barton (former Indiana Theatre pipe organ) installed at the Warren Performing Arts Center in Indianapolis, IN.
